Rules and Policies:

1. **Fees and Refund Policy:** fees are payable termly, in advance. Please note that all fees are non-refundable but can be transferred with advance notice only from one course to another. Should a child's family be re-located outside of HK, a refund for the remaining sessions will be given provided we receive an advance written notice of at least 21 days. The value of the refund will not include missed sessions prior to the written notice, nor the 21 days notification period. Refunds will not be made to students who withdraw once a class is running. A course runs on the basis of the required number of students enrolling, this makes the course financially viable. The programme is then committed to pay the coaches, rental and for any expenses incurred.
2. Payment by cheque should be crossed and made payable to "GLOBAL SPORTS" by mail to : P.O. BOX 65350, Tseung Kwan O Post Office. No post dated cheques will be accepted.
3. Children must be the minimum age stated, by or on the 1st day of classes.
4. There are no formal entry qualifications required.
5. **Make Up Class Policy:** in the event of an extended illness or hospitalisation (substantiated by a doctor's note), the child will be entitled to make up the sessions missed either within the scheduled term or the following term. Regretfully, there will be no refunds. Make up policy does not apply to non-attendance of classes due to inclement weather conditions or other personal reasons.
6. There is no regular training sessions on all Government and Int'l Schools listed Holidays. These dates are not included in session fees.
7. Once you have made application to a course, please assume you are enrolled. If a course cannot run you will be notified ASAP. Receipt will be issued at the first lesson. All classes are subject to cancellation as a result of insufficient registration.
8. Please kindly be notified of the following special arrangement during the typhoon season:
 - a) All classes will be automatically cancelled if Typhoon signal #8 or higher or BLACK rainstorm signal is hoisted TWO hours before the class commences.
 - b) If typhoon signal #8 or higher or BLACK rainstorm signals are released TWO hours before the class commences, class will be resumed as normal. You will not be informed separately about coming to class then.
 - c) When the Education Department announces TWO hours before the class commences that closure of all schools due to considerable risk to children from heavy rain or flooding, the class will be cancelled.
 - d) No make-up class or refund will be arranged because such cancel is out of human control. However players is welcome to the class in the Kowloon Cricket Club of the following Saturday 9:30 - 10:30AM for aged 6 - 9; 11:15 - 12:15pm for aged 10+.
 - e) Please pay attention to the announcement of the Observatory.
9. Judo suit white and blue are available for purchasing from coaches at the class, which cost: Size 000 estimated aged 4 & 5 - \$220, Size 00 estimated aged 6 - \$230, Size 0 estimated aged 7 - \$250, Size 1 estimated aged 8 - \$270, Size 2 estimated aged 9 - \$290, Size 3 estimated aged 10 - \$310, Size 4 estimated aged 11 - \$330, Size 5 estimated aged 13 - \$360, Size 6 estimated aged 15 - \$390
Global Sports Badges: \$70 each, T-Shirt: small: \$60, medium: \$70, large: \$80 and extra-large: \$90
10. Judo mon grade examination will be held once a year for white to green belt players. The next grading will be in April to May 2009, players will have to enter the open championships organized by the Judo Association of Hong Kong as their practical test. Further information will be announced in January 2009.
11. Local / Overseas Judo Training camp normally organized during Government and Int'l Schools listed Holidays.
12. Special notes to parents:
 - a) if your child suffers from illness, please let us know, or if they need to take any medication at lesson's time.
 - b) notification should be given when cancelling or absence from lesson's, at least 24 hours in advance.
 - c) notification of a change in personal circumstances (i.e. change of address) must be given to be update.
 - d) please leave the coaching to us! Talk to your child or the coach before or after the training if you have any questions.
 - e) parents are welcome to observe only on special occasions, otherwise, it is distracting to the children.
 - f) allow your child to show you at home on soft surface, e.g. mattress what she or he has learned, but do not experiment on non-judo players.
 - g) we want to know if there is something troubling your son or daughter at judo lessons. Sometimes, very small things can be big things to a young person. If we know about their problems, we can often help them over a hurdle to improve their physical and emotional development.
13. No jewellery or accessories should be worn during training. Global Sports is not responsible for any loss or damage of such things.

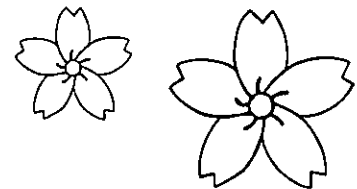
